Internship Program:

Phoenix Interfaith Counseling is committed to contributing to the community by providing the highest quality training for graduate students, new therapists, and mental health practitioners.

The Phoenix Interfaith Counseling Internship Program provides graduate students enrolled in counseling, marriage and family therapy or social work programs, the opportunity to see clients and be supervised in both individual and group environments. This structured internship program enables graduate students to practice skills they learned in their graduate program while participating in a clinical setting that operates from empirically based treatment orientations. Interns will receive some exposure to training in DBT, CBT, and ACT strategies, though they will not be expected to utilize the models in their clinical work.

The internship program requires a 9-12 month commitment, and is offered year round based on clinical capacity. Interns are placed at our Tempe, 16th Street, and West Valley sites based on availability and their geographic location. The Internship Program consists of the following weekly commitments:

- 10 scheduled client hours (individual, family or group)
- 1-2 hours individual supervision (based on program requirements)
- 2 hours group supervision (for intern cohorts of 4 or more)
- 2-3 hours local office staff meetings/DBT consultation group
- Daily documentation/paperwork/other administrative tasks
